

MSI-Joomla Engine Guide

I. Prerequisites

- ✓ BBPixel Core Engine 1.x
- ✓ Joomla 1.5.x
- ✓ PHP 4.1.x or later
- ✓ Mysql 4.1.x or later

II. Clean new installation

A. Copy Files

1. Rename "**upload\joomla\msicore\config.php-dist**" to "**config.php**"
2. Edit "**config.php**" above and fill in All necessary settings value via comment instructions.
Note: this config.php file is the same with the one of MSI Core Engine, you can take a copy from MSI Core Engine and put it here.
3. Copy all files + folders inside "**upload\joomla**" to **Joomla root path**, ex: yoursite.com/joomla.
This step might be overwritten some Joomla core files but it is fine.
4. Copy all files + folders inside "**upload\msi**" to **MSI core root path**, ex: yoursite.com/msi.

B. MSI :: plug-in

- Point browser to "**yoursite.com/joomla/msicore/install.php**" and do as its instruction.

Note:

- 1.** You **Must Backup your Joomla + MSI database** first.
- 2.** This installer script can be only run at once. Remember to delete this installer file for your own security.

C. Synchronize Users

- Login to MSI Core Engine -> Synchronize -> Status
- Click Synchronize icon of Core Plug-in first, then to Joomla Plug-in





Note: If there is duplicate record Error occurred, clicking on Fixes icon of Joomla Plug-in and try again.

D. Joomla :: plug-ins - modules

You must login to Joomla ACP and access to Plug-ins Manage or Modules Manage to do update/install these files below.

1. Plug-in - authentication :: plugin.auth.msi.zip

- Description: This plug-in is used for controlling Joomla authentication system such as login/logout/register.
- Installing
 - o Import plugin.auth.msi.zip
 - o Disable **Authentication - Joomla** plug-in
 - o Enable BBPixel plug-in just imported

2. Plug-in - system :: plugin.system.msi.zip

- Description: This plug-in is used for initializing MSI core engine for Joomla.
- Installing:
 - o Import plugin.system.msi.zip
 - o Enable BBPixel plug-in just imported

3. Module - login :: mod.login.msi.zip

- Description: This module is used for displaying Login box of MSI core engine
- Installing:
 - o Import module.login.msi.zip
 - o Enable BBPixel module just imported

III. Upgrading

Do like Section II -> A -> 3 + 4 above

IV. Note

- MSI engine now will control User registration, userCP and User Management. So you will need to take note to use MSI engine instead of the one of Joomla.
