Requirements

- Joomla 3.0.x must be installed
- **The current working versions are for: Joomla 3.0.x**

Module Installation

1. Joomla Admin > Extensions > Extension manager > Install
2. Select now the File > lof_articleslideshow.zip
3. Click "Upload & Install"

Module Configuration

Joomla Admin > Extensions > Module Manager > LOF Article Slider Module

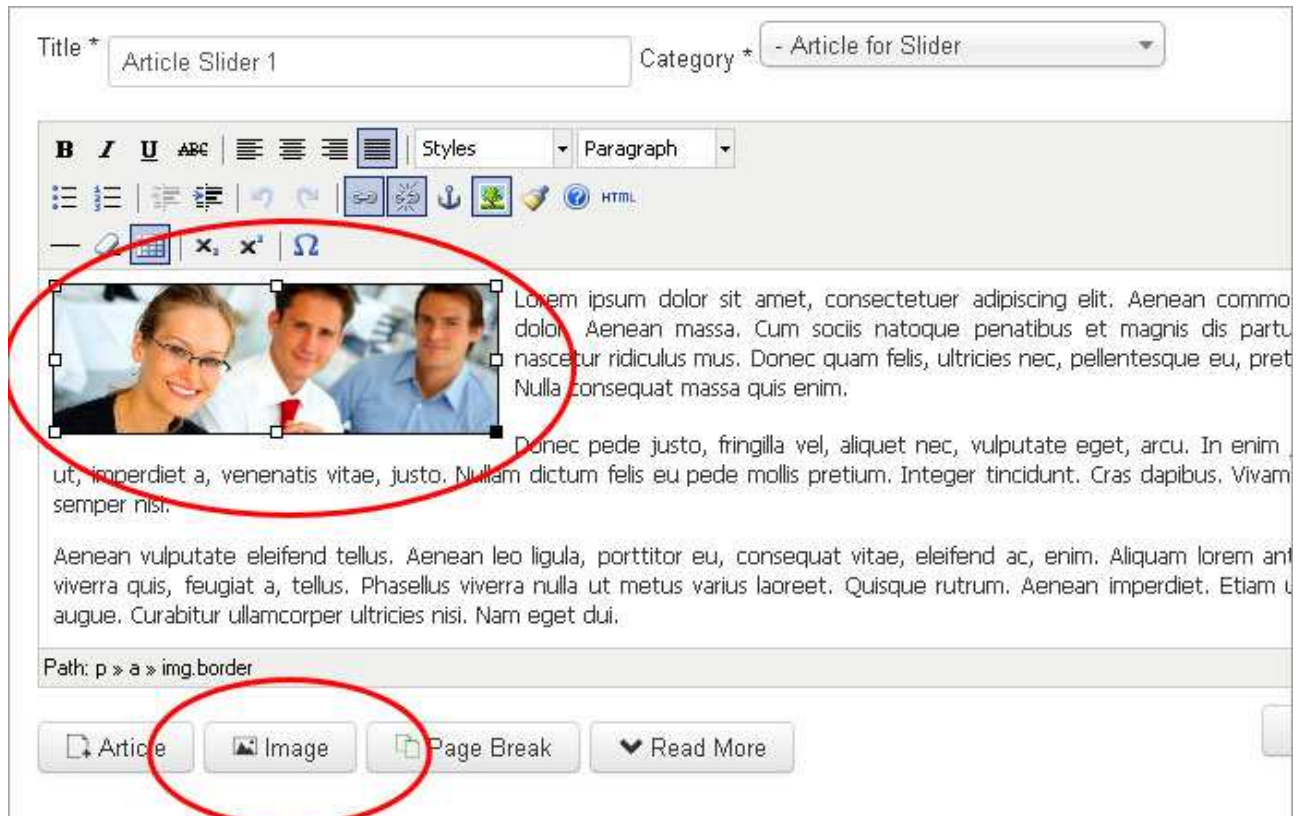
1. Joomla Admin > Extensions > Module Manager > LOF Article Slider Module
2. Show Title = Hide
3. Status = Published
4. Module Assignment = On all Pages
5. Module position = slideshow

Prepare before your run the Slider

1. Create a category with individual name like: **"slider content"**
2. Create a Joomla article and assign the article to this category

How to add an image to the Slider


1. Insert an image to the article, see picture below
2. The image must be the first image at the article
3. Shrink now the image to your preferred width (Hold "Shift" for proportional shrink)



1. Please use JPG's with max 150 kilobyte
2. Your image must have the same width and height as shown on
