1. Template Configuration Instructions

1.1. Template configuration

Go to menu **Extensions** → **Template Manager**.

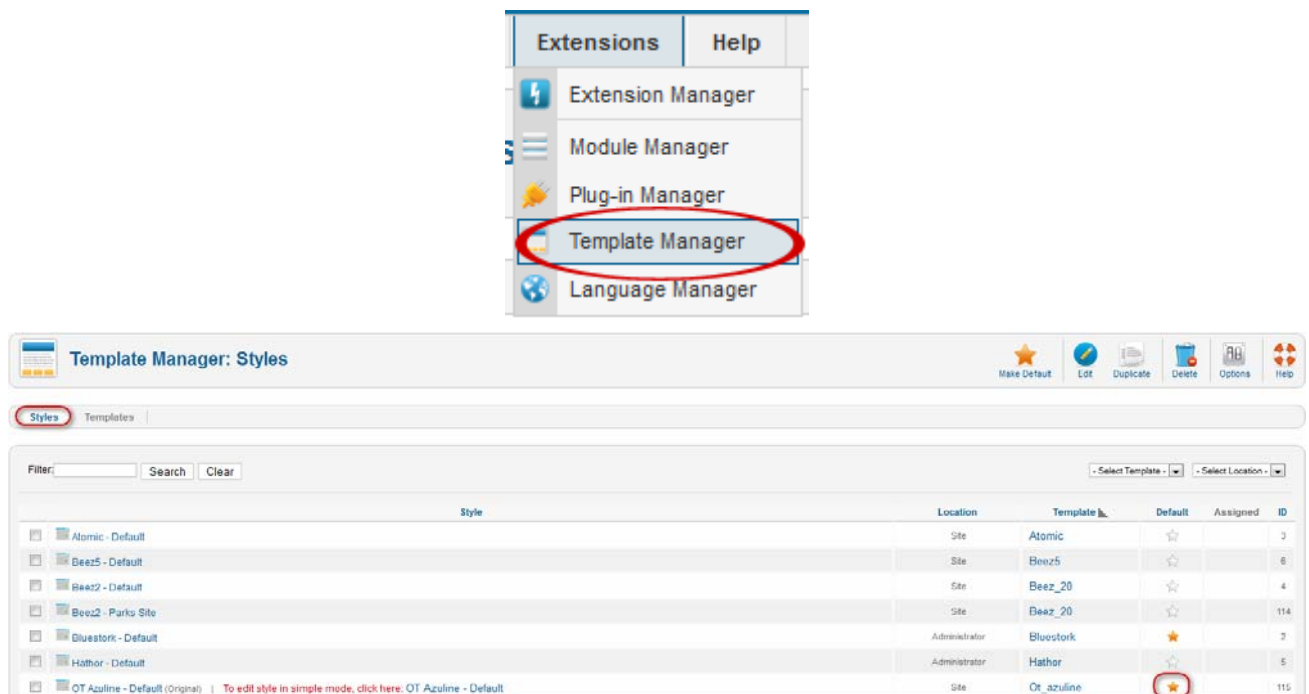


Figure 1: Template manager – make template default with default style

The template manager at **Style view** will list all the templates (site and admin templates). You can see the new template that we've installed. To set it default template, click the “**STAR**” button as [Figure 1](#) (or by choosing the checkbox then click **Make Default** button at the top right bar).

Once chosen default template, the front-end change to display with new template.

If you want to edit this template's style with preset options or menu assign, just click to template's name at the list (or choose it by checkbox then click Edit button).

So, better if you install quick-start package (demos package) first then using it as is the sample to follow all configurations.

2. Extensions installation and configuration instructions

2.1. Extensions installation

Installing an extension (module, plugin, component, etc.) is the same as installing a template. So installing process will follow the steps as section [Error! Reference source not found.](#).

In this package, we attached module named **pkg_omg.zip**, **pkg_omgmenu mod_ot_lightboxlogin.zip** and **mod_ot_banners.zip**. You need to install them then follow below sections to configure them.

Note: To find the module you need to configure, in backend, go to menu Extensions → Module Manager.

2.2. OMG Menu module configurations

OMG Menu module display **Main Menu** with **dropdown** and **Multicolumns** with the each **Column** you can include **Module** and **Item Description**, **Custom Item Text Color** via **OT Main Menu Plugin Parameters**.

2.2.1. OMG Menu Module

At the **Details** area, choose the options as below figure ([Figure 6: OMG Menu module – details](#))

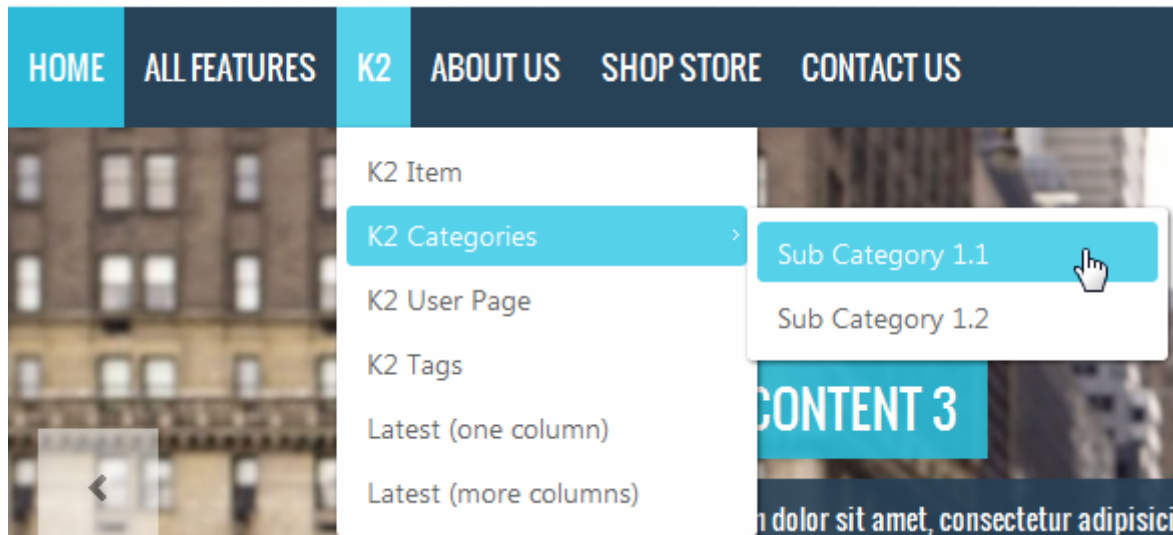


Figure 7: OMG Menu module – general view





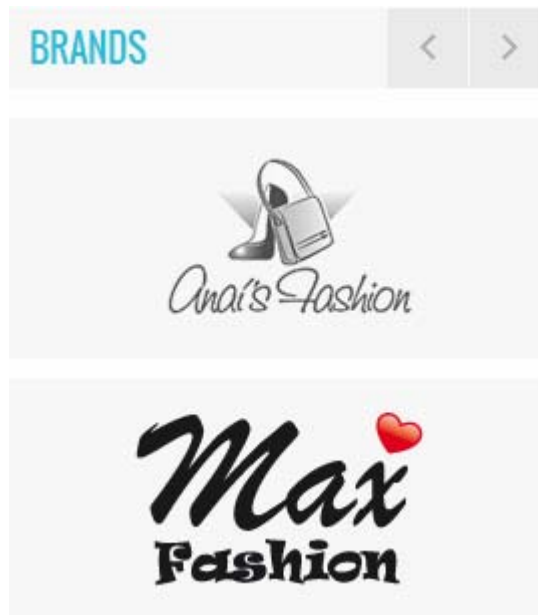


Figure 13: OT Banner module – general view

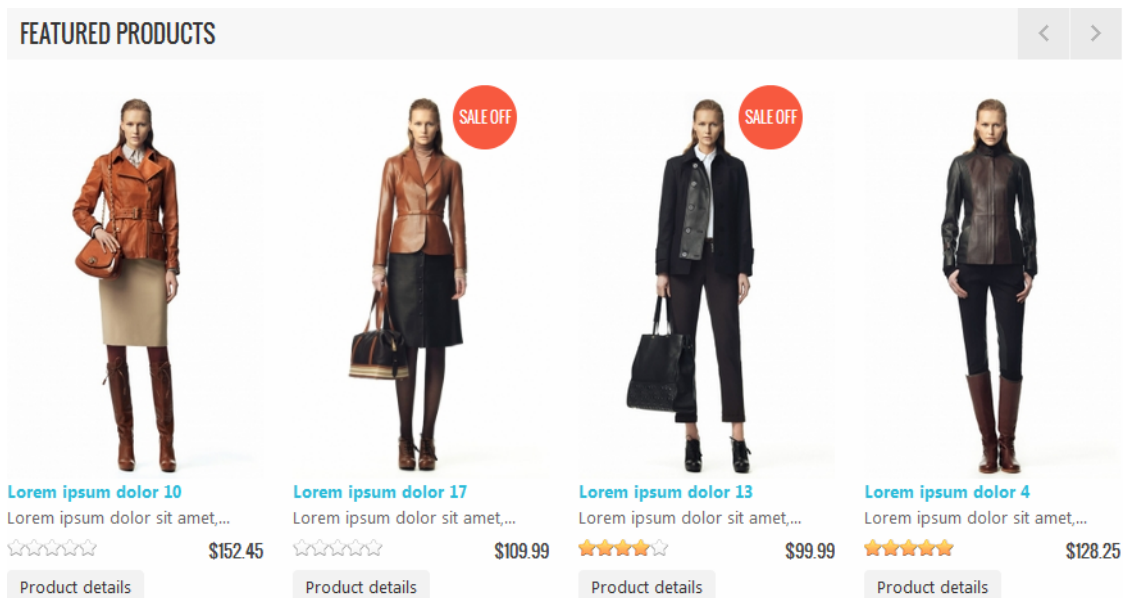


Figure 17: Virtuemart Products module – General view
